### I. The temporary stumbling (Romans 11:11) and blindness (Romans 11:25) of the nation Israel. Romans 11:28-32

#### A. The nation Israel became an enemy to the gospel. Romans 11:28, 1 Thessalonians 2:14-16

##### 1. This allows the Gentiles to become the body of Christ.

Romans 11:30, Acts 13:46, Ephesians 1:22-23

#### B. By election the nation Israel will be restored. Romans 11:28, 31, Deuteronomy 4:31

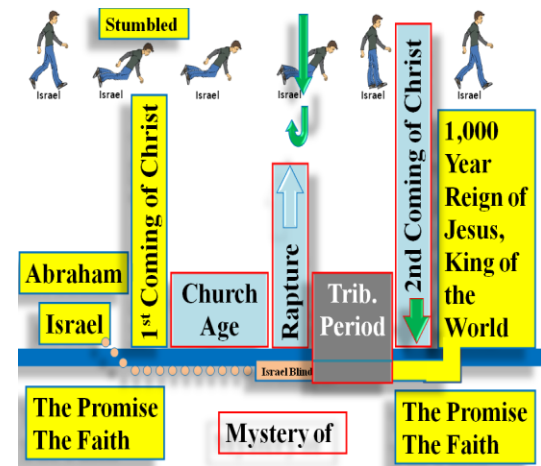

### III. All are lost and must be saved. Romans 11:32, Romans 3:9-10, Galatians 3:22, 1 Timothy 2:3-6, John 3:16

### IV. The depth of God's wisdom and knowledge. Romans 11:33-34

#### A. His judgments are unsearchable. Romans 11:33

#### B. His ways are past finding out! Romans 11:33, Isaiah 55:8-9



**C. Who knows the mind of God? Romans 11:34, Isaiah 40:13-14**

- 1. There is no way that you can know the things of God unless God reveals them to you. 1 Corinthians 2:14-16**
- 2. God wants you to know these things. 1 Corinthians 2:9-13, Deuteronomy 29:29, Luke 8:10**

**V. To whom does God owe any thing? Romans 11:35-36**

- A. God is the creator of all things, and by him all things exists. Romans 11:36, Colossians 1:16-17**
