There are two types of baptism.

1. Physical with spiritual meaning. Acts 8:36

**2. Spiritual with physical meaning.
1 Corinthians 12:13**

into Jesus Christ

Galatians 3:27

were baptized into his death?

There are different modes of baptism.

1. Pouring

2. Sprinkling

3. Immersion

Baptism is to teach death, burial and resurrection.

Baptism – βαπτίζω baptizo *bap-tid'-zo* means:

to immerse

to submerge

to put under

to bury.

Therefore we are buried Vs. 4

with him

by baptism

into death:

that like as Christ

was raised up from the dead

by the glory of the Father,

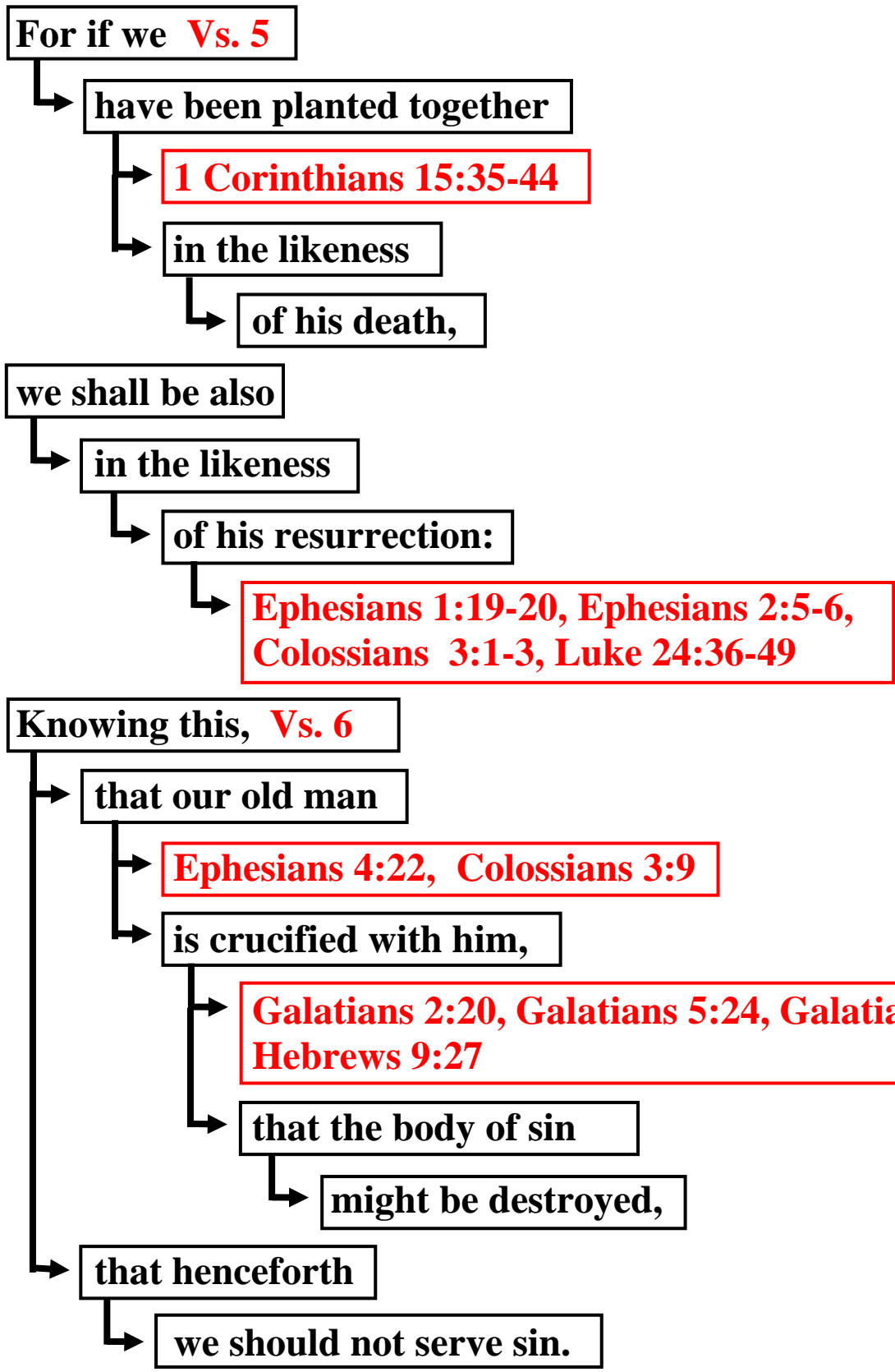
Colossians 2:12, 1 Corinthians 6:14

even so we

also should walk

in newness of life.

For he that is dead Vs. 7

is freed from sin.

Now if we Vs. 8

be dead with Christ,

we believe that

we shall also live with him:

**2 Timothy 2:11, John 14:19, 2 Corinthians 4:14, Colossians 3:4,
1 Thessalonians 4:14-17**

Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead Vs. 9

dieth no more;

death hath no more dominion over him.

Acts 2:24, Hebrews 7:25; 2:14-15

For in that he died, Vs. 10

he died unto sin once:

Hebrews 9:26-28, 1 Peter 3:18, Hebrews 10:12

but in that he liveth,

he liveth unto God.



I. Your old life is dead with Jesus. **Romans 6:6**

A. Sin is not to have control in your body. **Romans 6:12**

B. Do not yield. **Romans 6:13**

1. The Greek word for “yield” is *paristhmi paristemi par-is'-tay-mee* or prolonged *paristanw paristano par-is-tan'-o*

1) to place beside or near

1a) to set at hand

1a1) to present

1a2) to proffer

1a3) to provide

1a4) to place a person or thing at one's disposal

1a5) to present a person for another to see and question

1a6) to present or show

1a7) to bring to, bring near

1a8) metaph. i.e to bring into one's fellowship or intimacy

1b) to present (show) by argument, to prove

2) to stand beside, stand by or near, to be at hand, be present

2a) to stand by

2a1) to stand beside one, a bystander

2b) to appear

2c) to be at hand, stand ready

2d) to stand by to help, to succour

2e) to be present

2e1) to have come
