II. In Luke 16:19-24 Jesus tells us what a soul looks like.

Luke 16:19 “There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day:

20 “And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,

21 “And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man’s table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

22 “And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham’s bosom:”

Luke 16:22 “the rich man also died, and was buried;”

23 “And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.”

Luke 16:27 “Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father’s house:

28 “For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.”

Luke 16:23 “And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.”

24 "And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame."

- A. Jesus is not talking about the finger of the body of Lazarus because that body is in the grave, not in heaven. Jesus is talking about the finger of the soul of Lazarus that is in Heaven.**
- B. Jesus is not talking about the tongue of the body of the rich man because that body is in the grave, not in hell. Jesus is talking about the tongue of the soul of the rich man that is in hell.**

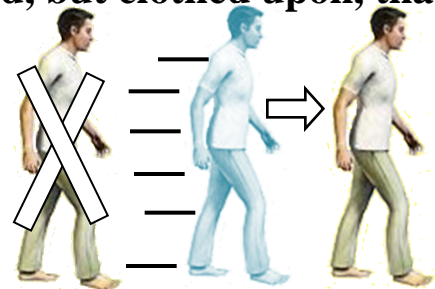
2 “For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:
