

# Tabernacle Lesson 3

## The Altar of the Burnt Offering

- 1. The brazen altar is \_\_\_\_\_ cubits long and \_\_\_\_ cubits wide and \_\_\_\_ cubits high. Since a cubit equals 18 inches, the brazen altar is 7 feet, 6 inches long, 7 feet, 6 inches wide and 4 feet, 6 inches high.
- 2. Exodus 27:1 "And thou shalt make an altar of shittim wood, five cubits long, and five cubits broad; the altar shall be foursquare: and the height thereof shall be three cubits."



3. The brazen altar is carried by two staves made of shittim wood and overlaid with \_\_\_\_\_.

Exodus 27:6 "And thou shalt make staves for the altar, staves of shittim wood, and overlay them with brass."

Note: Brass is symbolic of judgment.





4 And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand."
30. The Altar of Incense is symbolic of Jesus making for us. Romans 8:34 "Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us." Hebrews 7:25 "Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them."
31. The Altar of Incense is placed before the of the most holy place (the first room under the Tabernacle).  Exodus 30:6-7 "And thou shalt put it before the vail that is by the ark
of the testimony, before the mercy seat that is over the testimony, where I will meet with thee.  7 And Aaron shall burn thereon sweet incense every morning:

### The Ark of the Testimony

The Hebrew word, *Arown*, which is translated "ark" in Exodus 25:22 and Exodus 26:33 literally means coffin. The Ark of Testimony in the Holy of Holies is a coffin that is symbolic of the death of Jesus.

Exodus 25:22 "And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel."

Exodus 26:33 "And thou shalt hang up the vail under the taches, that thou mayest bring in thither within the vail the ark of the testimony: and the vail shall divide unto you between the holy place and the most holy."

32. The ark is \_\_\_ cubits and a half long and a \_\_\_\_ and a half wide and high. Since a cubit equals 18 inches, the ark is 3 feet, 9 inches long, 2 feet, 3 inches wide and 2 feet 3 inches high.

Exodus 25:10 "And they shall make an ark of shittim wood: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof, and a cubit and a half the height thereof."



33. The ark is made of shittim wood and is overlaid with within and without.  Exodus 25:11 "And thou shalt overlay it with pure gold, within and without shalt thou overlay it, and shalt make upon it a crown of gold round about."
34. The ark is to have rings made of gold in the four with two rings on each  Exodus 25:12 "And thou shalt cast four rings of gold for it, and put them in the four corners thereof; and two rings shall be in the one side of it, and two rings in the other side of it."

The ark is carried by two staves made of shittim wood and overlaid with</li> <li>Exodus 25:13-16 "And thou shalt make staves of shittim wood, and overlay them with gold.</li> <li>14 And thou shalt put the staves into the rings by the sides of the ark, that the ark may be borne with them.</li> <li>15 The staves shall be in the rings of the ark: they shall not be taken from it.</li> <li>16 And thou shalt put into the ark the testimony which I shall give thee."</li> </ul>
36. On top of the ark is a lid that is called the seat.  Exodus 25:21 "And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee."
37. The mercy seat is made of pure  Exodus 25:17 "And thou shalt make a mercy seat of pure gold: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof."

38. A Cherubim is placed at each end of the mercy seat with their \_\_\_\_\_ stretched forth covering the mercy seat.


Exodus 25:20 "And the cherubims shall stretch forth their wings on high, covering the mercy seat with their wings, and their faces shall look one to another; toward the mercy seat shall the faces of the cherubims be."


