Communion

1 Corinthians 10:14 “Wherefore, my dearly beloved, flee from idolatry.

15 I speak as to wise men; judge ye what I say.”

Q1. The Bible speaks to \_\_\_\_\_ men.

Matthew 7:24 “Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:”

Q2. A person who hears and does what the Bible teaches is a \_\_\_\_\_ man.

1 Corinthians 10:16 “The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?”

Q3. The cup of blessing is the communion of the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ.

Mark 14:23 “And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave *it* to them: and they all drank of it.

24 And he said unto them, This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many.

25 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.”

Q4. The wine in the cup is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the vine, which is unfermented.

1 Corinthians 11:25 “After the same manner also *he took* the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink *it*, in remembrance of me.”

Q5. We are to drink the cup in \_\_\_\_\_ of the blood of Jesus.

1 Corinthians 10:16 “The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?”

Q 6. The bread is the communion of the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ.

1 Corinthians 11:23 “For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the *same* night in which he was betrayed took bread: 24 And when he had given thanks, he brake *it*, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.”

Q7. We are to eat the bread in \_\_\_\_\_ of the body of Christ.

1 Corinthians 11:27 “Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink *this* cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.”

Q8. If you drink the cup and eat the bread unworthily, you will be \_\_\_\_\_ of the body and blood of the Lord.

1 Corinthians 11:28 “But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of *that* bread, and drink of *that* cup.”

Q9. Who is to examine a person as to whether they are worthy to eat the bread and drink the cup? \_\_\_\_\_

1 Corinthians 11:29 “For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord’s body.

30 For this cause many *are* weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.”

Q10. A person may get \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and die if they do not repent of their sins and ask for forgiveness by the blood of Jesus before they eat the bread and drink the cup.

Ephesians 1:22 “And hath put all *things* under his feet, and gave him *to be* the head over all *things* to the church,

23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.”

Q11. A local church is the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 10:17 “For we *being* many are one bread, *and* one body: for we are all partakers of that one bread.”

Q12. The local church is \_\_\_\_\_ bread and one body of Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 10:16 “The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?”
