1 Corinthians 11: 17 "Now in this that I declare unto you I praise you not, that ye come together not for the better, but for the worse."
Q1. As a church, we are to come together for the not the
Hebrews 10:25 "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some <i>is</i> ; but exhorting <i>one another</i> : and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching."
Q2. As a church, we are to forsake the assembling of ourselves
Q3. As a church, we are to one another realizing the return of Jesus.
1 Corinthians 11:18 "For first of all, when ye come together in the church, I hear that there be divisions among you; and I partly believe it."
Q4. As a church, we are not to have among us.
1 Corinthians 1:10 "Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and <i>that</i> there be no divisions among you; but <i>that</i> ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment."
Q5. As a church, we are to be perfectly together in the same
1 Corinthians 11: 19 "For there must be also heresies among you, that they which are approved may be made manifest among you."
Q6. As a church, there will be among us.
1 Timothy 4:1 "Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;"
Q7. As a church, some shall depart from the

2 Peter 2:1 "But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction."
Q8. As a church, there will be false and among us.
2 Corinthians 13:5 "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?"
Q9. As a church, we are to ourselves to see that we are in the
1 Corinthians 11: 20 "When ye come together therefore into one place, this is not to eat the Lord's supper."
Q10. As a church, the Lord's supper is to be treated as a time of fellowship.
1 Corinthians 11: 21 "For in eating every one taketh before other his own supper: and one is hungry, and another is drunken."
Q11. As a church, we are not to have a fellowship eating our supper without sharing it with one another.
1 Corinthians 11: 22 "What? have ye not houses to eat and to drink in? or despise ye the church of God, and shame them that have not? What shall I say to you? shall I praise you in this? I praise you not."
Q12. As a church, we are not to them that have not.
