I. The symbols of the Passover.

A. The body of a lamb without blemish.

Exodus 12:5 "Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take *it* out from the sheep, or from the goats:"

A. The fruit of the vine.

Luke 22:17 "And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide *it* among yourselves:

18 For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come."
