1 Corinthians 11:27-34 The Lord's Supper Part II

1 Corinthians 11:27 "Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink <i>this</i> cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord."
Q1. When a person partakes in the Lord's supper will be of the body and blood of the Lord.
1 Corinthians 11:34 "And if any man hunger, let him eat at home; that ye come not together unto condemnation. And the rest will I set in order when I come."
Q2. When the Lord's supper is like a fellowship dinner, the partakers are unworthy. They should eat at, not at the Lord's supper.
Hebrews 10:28 "He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: 29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought <u>worthy</u> , who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?"
Q3. When a believer will not confess and repent of their daily sins, they have underfoot the death of Jesus and have counted the of Jesus as nothing. They are unworthy to partake of the Lord's supper.
1 Corinthians 11:28 "But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of <i>that</i> bread, and drink of <i>that</i> cup."
Q4. Before anyone partakes of the Lord's supper, they are to themselves.
1 John 1:9 "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us <i>our</i> sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."
Q5. We are to our sins and ask God to forgive us.
Colossians 1:14 "In whom we have redemption through his blood, <i>even</i> the forgiveness of sins:"

Q6. We can have forgiveness of our sins through the of Jesus and be worthy to partake of the Lord's supper.
1 Corinthians 11:28 "But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup."
Q7. Is the word repent in 1 Corinthians 11:28?
Q8. After the saved examine themselves, they are to of the Lord's supper worthy or unworthy.
1 Corinthians 11:29 "For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body."
Q9. If a person partakes of the Lord's supper unworthily, they bring to themselves.
1 Corinthians 11:30 "For this cause many <i>are</i> weak and sickly among you, and many sleep."
Q10. The damnation is they will become and and could die.
1 Corinthians 11:31 "For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged."
Q11. If we ourselves and repent, we will not be judged.
1 Corinthians 11:32 "But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world."
Q12. If we are judged by God, we will be by the Lord, that we would be judged with the world.
1 Corinthians 11:33 "Wherefore, my brethren, when ye come together to eat, tarry one for another."
Q13. We are to and encourage one another to be worthy through forgiveness by the blood of Jesus as we partake of the Lord's supper.
