1 Corinthians 12:9 “To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;”

How does God heal people?

Acts 3:6 “Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.”

Ac 3:7 “And he took him by the right hand, and lifted *him* up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.”

Mark 2:3 “And they come unto him, bringing one sick of the palsy, which was borne of four.

4 And when they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken *it* up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay.

5 When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee.”

Q3. The man was sick because of sins and Jesus saw \_\_\_\_\_ faith and he was healed.

Matthew 8:13 “And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, *so* be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.”

Q4. The servant was healed because of the centurion's \_\_\_\_\_.

Mark 10:51 “And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight.

52 And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.”

Q5. The blind man was healed because of his \_\_\_\_\_.

**Matthew 8:14** “And when Jesus was come into Peter’s house, he saw his wife’s mother laid, and sick of a fever.

**15** And he touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them.”

**Q6.** Peter’s mother-in-law was healed when Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ her hand.

**Mark 8:22** “And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him.

**23** And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought.

**24** And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking.

**25** After that he put *his* hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.”

**Q7.** Was this man healed all at once or over a period of time? \_\_\_\_\_.

**James 5:14** “Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:”

**Q8.** Healing may come by \_\_\_\_\_ and the anointing of \_\_\_\_\_ (medicine).

**James 5:15** “And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.”

**John 9:1** “And as *Jesus* passed by, he saw a man which was blind from *his* birth.

**2** And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?

**3** Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.

**John 9:6** When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay,

**7** And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.”
