1 Corinthians 13:1 "Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become <i>as</i> sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal."

There are three Greek words for love.
1. <25>ἀγαπάω agapao $ag$ - $ap$ - $ah$ '- $o$ , translated as love 135 times and beloved 7 times. Never as charity.
2. <5368>φιλέω phileo <i>fil-eh'-o</i> , translated as love 22 times and kiss 3 times. Never as charity.
3. <26>ἀγάπη agape $ag$ - $ah$ '- $pay$ , translated as love 86 times, charity 27 times, dear 1 time, charitably 1 time and feast of charity 1 time.
1 John 2:15 " <u>Love</u> [ag-ap-ah'-o(delight)] not the world, neither the things that are in the world If any man <u>love</u> [ag-ap-ah'-o (desire)] the world, the <u>love</u> [ag-ah'-pay (charity)] of the Father is not in him."
You can love by desire, lust, and enjoyment.
You can love by choice with charity.
