1. <25>ἀγαπάω agapao *ag-ap-ah'-o*, translated as love 135 times and beloved 7 times. Never as charity.

2. <5368>φιλέω phileo *fil-eh'-o*, translated as love 22 times and kiss 3 times. Never as charity.

3. <26>ἀγάπη agape *ag-ah'-pay*, translated as love 86 times, charity 27 times, dear 1 time, charitably 1 time and feast of charity 1 time.
