
## 1 Corinthians 13:7 Charity endureth all things

1 Corinthians 13:7 "Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things."



What does the phrase "all things" mean when used with charity?

Matthew 19:26 "But Jesus beheld *them*, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible."

Q7. With men, many things are
Q8. Only with God are possible.
The phrase "all things" used with charity means charity is the miracle of God's love.
Q9. Charity is the miracle of God's love, which makes possible.
Matthew 21:22 "And $\underline{all}$ $\underline{things}$ , whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive."
There are three Greek words for love.
<ol> <li>&lt;25&gt;ἀγαπάω agapao ag-ap-ah'-o, translated as love 135 times and beloved 7 times. Never as charity.</li> </ol>
2. <5368>φιλέω phileo <i>fil-eh'-o</i> , translated as love 22 times and kiss 3 times. Never as charity.

- 3.  $<26>\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta$  agape ag-ah'-pay, translated as love 86 times, charity 27 times, dear 1 time, charitably 1 time and feast of charity 1 time.
- 1 John 2:15 "Love not the world, neither the things *that are* in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- 16 For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world."
- 1 John 2:15 "Love [ag-ap-ah'-o(the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life)] not the world, neither the things that are in the world If any man love [ag-ap-ah'-o (the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life)] the world, the love [ag-ah'-pay] of the Father is not in him."

Q10. The love of the \_\_\_\_\_ is ag-ah'-pay.

When love, ag-ah'-pay, is translated as charity, then it is the miracle of God's love.

When you use the miracle of God's love, then you are loving as charity.
