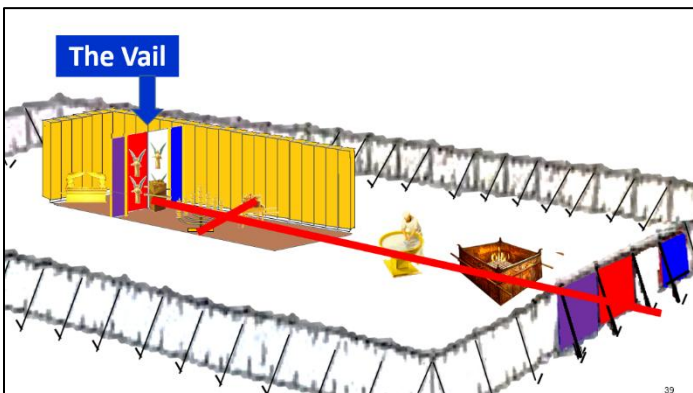
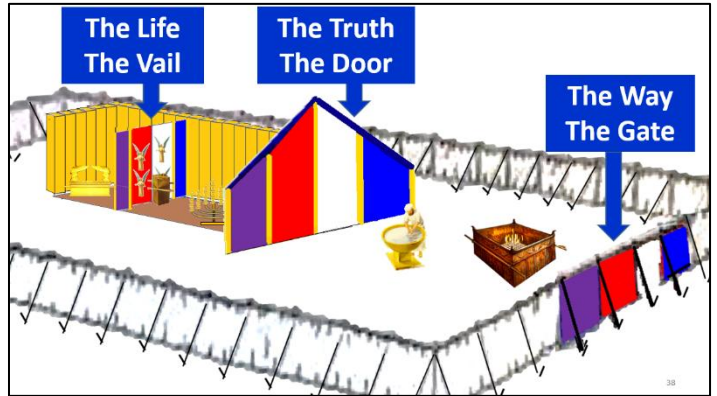
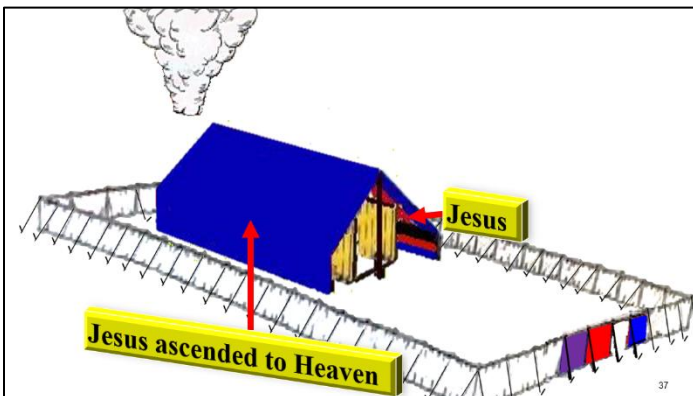
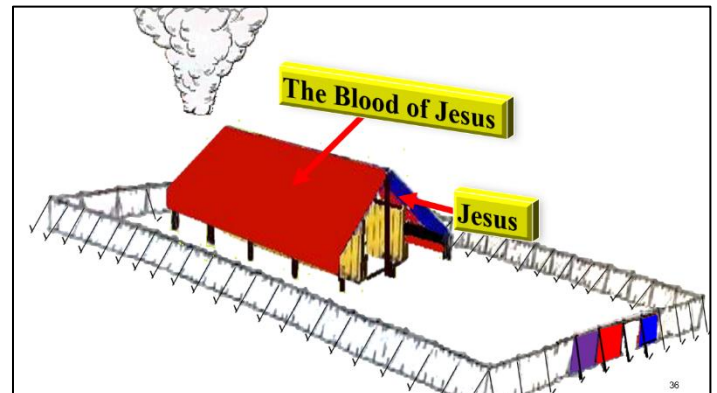
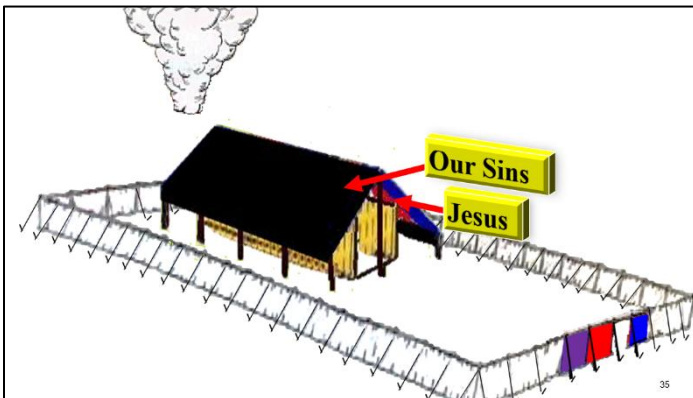
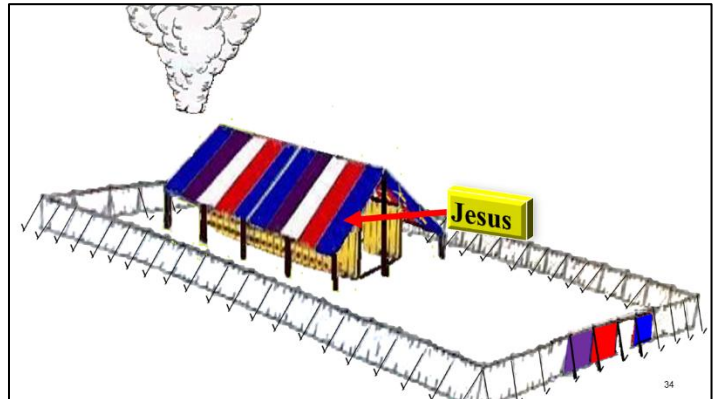
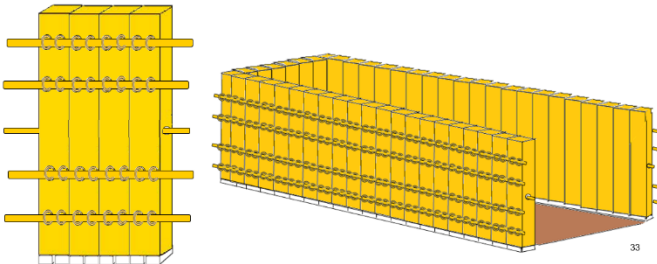
Q6. The boards and bars under the Tabernacle are symbolic of the local church which is the building _____ framed together, groweth unto an holy _____ in the Lord.

Center bar symbolic of the Holy Spirit in the local churches.

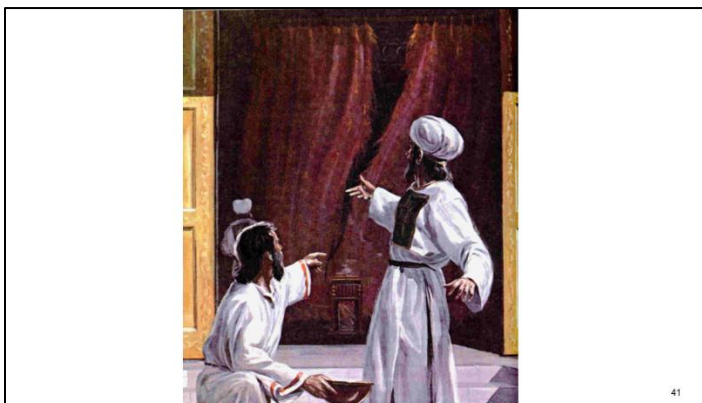
