What happened at the resurrection of Jesus Christ?

1 Corinthians 15:51 “Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,”

Q1. At the Rapture, we will all be _____ because of the resurrection of Christ.

Some miraculous changes were made at the resurrection of Jesus Christ!

Matthew 27:57 “When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus’ disciple:

58 He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered.”

Q2. At the death of Jesus on the cross, Joseph went to Pilate and begged for the _____ of Jesus.

Matthew 27:59 “And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth,

60 And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed.”
