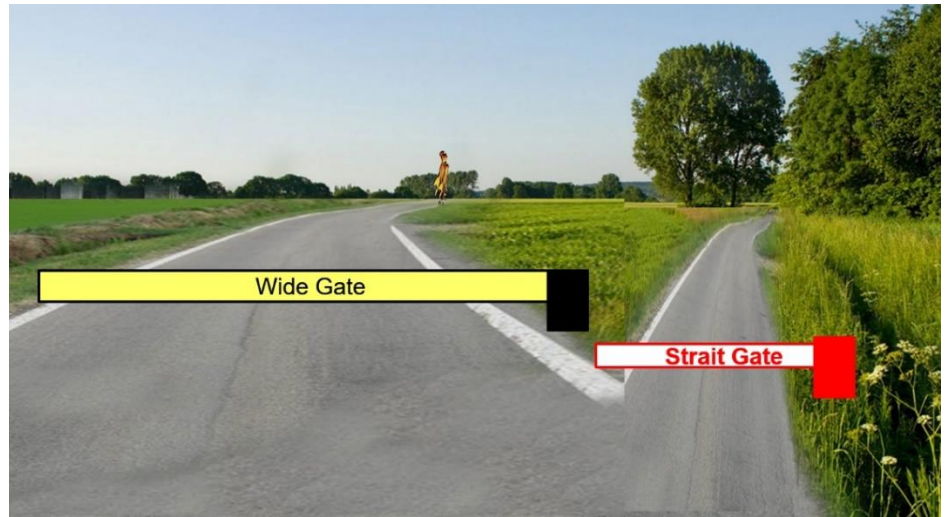

4. Will you pray admitting that you have sinned?

5. Will you pray repenting of your sins?

6. Will you pray asking God to forgive you and save you by the blood of Jesus?

You might say a prayer like this out loud:

"Dear God, I am sorry that I have sinned against you. I believe that Jesus is your son and he died for my sins, was buried, and raised the third day. I repent of my sins to follow your teachings in the Bible. Please forgive me of my sins and save me by the blood of Jesus. Thank you for saving my soul. In the name of Jesus I pray. Amen."
