

Angels Lesson 13

Angels Executing Punishment

Angels are used by God to execute punishment upon those who sin against him.

Genesis 19:10 “But the men put forth their hand, and pulled Lot into the house to them, and shut to the door.

11 And they smote the men that were at the door of the house with blindness, both small and great: so that they wearied themselves to find the door.”
