## **Angels Lesson 4**

## The Appearances and Shapes of Angels

In the Bible, there are recorded events of angels. In many of these events, the Bible does not describe how an angel appears or what shape or form the angel might have. There are a few events that give some description of what shape that angel might have and how he appeared to mankind.

I. Angels can appear in a flame of fire.

Exodus 3: 1 "Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb.

2 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed."

II. Angels can appear visible or invisible.

Numbers 22:22 "And God's anger was kindled because he went: and the angel of the LORD stood in the way for an adversary against him. Now he was riding upon his ass, and his two servants were with him.

23 And the ass saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his sword drawn in his hand: and the ass turned aside out of the way, and went into the field: and Balaam smote the ass, to turn her into the way."

Numbers 22:31 "Then the LORD opened the eyes of Balaam, and he saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his sword

drawn in his hand: and he bowed down his head, and fell flat on his face."



Therefore, an angel may be visible or seen by one and at the same time be invisible to others.

Colossians 1:16 "For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:"
Q5. God is the creator of the and world.
Angels can move from the invisible to the visible world or from the visible to the invisible world. They can have objects such as swords, chariots and horses that can also be taken from the invisible to the visible world or go from the visible to the invisible. The invisible world is just as real as the visible.
III. Angels can appear as chariots of fire.
When the Syrian army surrounded Elisha and his servant, Elisha saw the angels of God as horses and chariots of fire, but his servant saw nothing. After Elisha prayed, God opened the eyes of the servant, and he saw what was there

all the time: the horses and chariots of fire.

2 Kings 6:16 "And he answered, Fear not: for they that be with us are more than they that be with them.

17 And Elisha prayed, and said, Lord, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the Lord opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha."

Genesis 19:1 "And there came two angels to Sodom at even; and Lot sat in the gate of Sodom: and Lot seeing them rose up to meet them; and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground;

2 And he said, Behold now, my lords, turn in, I pray you, into your servant's house, and tarry all night, and wash your feet, and ye shall rise up early, and go on your ways. And they said, Nay; but we will abide in the street all night.

Genesis 19:4 But before they lay down, the men of the city, [even] the men of Sodom, compassed the house round, both old and young, all the people from every quarter:

5 And they called unto Lot, and said unto him, Where are the men which came in to thee this night? bring them out unto us, that we may know them."
