The Hebrew word for “vain” in Isaiah 45:18 is the same Hebrew word used for “form” in Genesis 1:3. 6

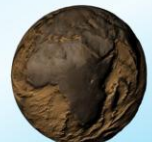
## Genesis 1:1

  - C. God said “Let there be light.” Genesis 1:3
  - D. Jesus is the light of the world. John 8:12
  - E. Jesus would come to give us light.
