Daniel 8:5-8

Lesson 18

Daniel 8:20 “The ram which thou sawest having *two* horns *are* the kings of Media and Persia.”

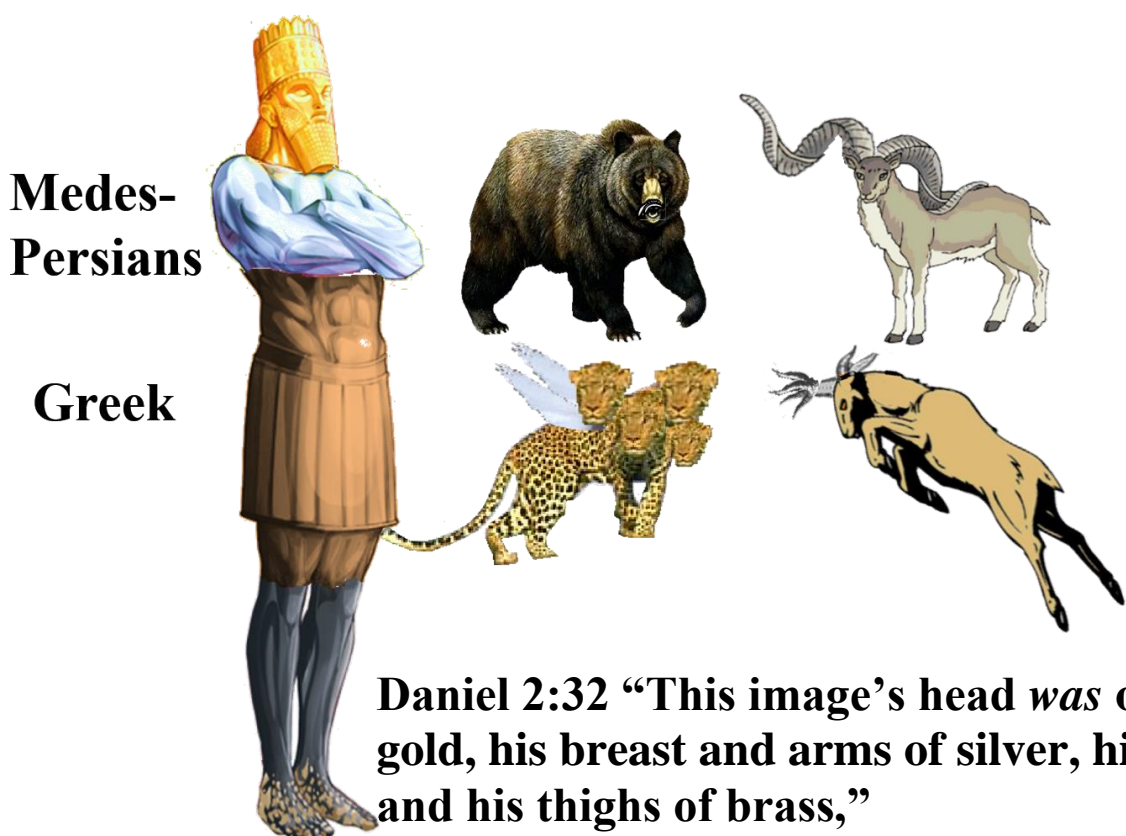
