  - A. Potiphar's wife wanted Joseph to go to bed with her. Vs. 7
  - B. Joseph refused. Vs. 8-9
    - 1. Joseph knew this was a sin against Potiphar and God.
  - C. Potiphar's wife tempted Joseph day by day, and he refused. Vs. 10
  - D. One day Joseph was alone with Potiphar's wife in the house. Vs. 11-13
    - 1. She caught him by his garment, and he fled leaving his garment in her hand.
  - E. Potiphar's wife falsely accused Joseph of trying to rape her. Vs. 14-19

  - A. Potiphar put Joseph in the king's prison. Vs. 20
  - B. The Lord was with Joseph in prison. Vs. 21
  - C. The Lord gave Joseph favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison. Vs. 21
  - D. The keeper of the prison put Joseph in charge of all that he had. Vs. 22
  - E. God made Joseph to prosper in all that he did. Vs. 23
