  - A. Jacob's sons did not want to go to Egypt. Vs. 1
  - B. Because of the famine, they must go to Egypt to buy corn. Vs. 2
  - C. Benjamin does not go with them to Egypt. Vs. 4
  - D. Joseph's brothers bowed down before him. Vs. 6
- II. Joseph accuses his brothers of being spies. Vs. 7-15
  - A. Joseph's brothers did not know him. Vs. 7-8
  - B. Joseph remembered his dreams about them. Vs. 9
  - C. Joseph accuses his brothers of being spies. Vs. 9-12
  - D. They tell Joseph that their father has 12 sons. Vs. 13
    - 1. One son is gone, and the youngest is at home.
  - E. Joseph wants them to bring the youngest son to him. Vs. 15
- III. Joseph put his brothers in prison as spies. Vs. 16-17
  - A. They are in prison for three days. Vs. 17
- IV. Joseph orders his brothers to bring Benjamin to him. Vs. 18-23
  - A. One of them is to remain in prison while they bring Benjamin back to him. Vs. 18-20
  - B. They talk among themselves in Hebrew, about how they treated Joseph many years ago and now this was their punishment. Vs. 21-22
  - C. They did not know that Joseph understood them in thinking that he was an Egyptian. Vs. 23
- V. Simeon is kept in prison until Benjamin is brought before Joseph. Vs. 24
- VI. Joseph had every man's money secretly restored in their sacks. Vs. 25-28
- VII. The brothers return home and tell Jacob. Vs. 29-35
- VIII. Jacob refuses to send Benjamin to Egypt. Vs. 36-38
