 - A. Joseph commands his steward to put his cup secretly into Benjamin's sack. Vs. 1-2**
 - B. The sons of Israel depart with the corn they had purchased. Vs. 3**
 - C. Joseph commands his steward to pursue them and charge them with having stolen his cup. Vs. 4-6**
 - D. Joseph's brothers excuse themselves and protest their innocence. Vs. 7-8**
 - E. They offer to submit to be slaves should the cup be found with any of them. Vs. 9-10**
 - F. Search is made, and the cup is found in Benjamin's sack. Vs. 10-12**
 - G. They are brought back and submit themselves to Joseph. Vs. 13-16**
 - H. Joseph determines that Benjamin alone, with whom the cup is found, shall remain in captivity. Vs. 17**
 - I. Judah pleads for Benjamin, and offers himself to be a bondman in his stead. Vs. 18-34**
