## Genesis 50

- I. The burial of Jacob. Vs. 1-13
  - A. Joseph has his physicians to embalm Jacob. Vs. 1-2
  - B. 40 days for embalmment plus 30 more days equals 70 days for mourning. Vs. 3
  - C. Joseph asks Pharaoh to let him bury his father in Canaan. Vs. 4-5
  - D. Pharaoh gives Joseph permission. Vs. 6
  - E. Joseph left for Canaan, with his family and a great host of Egyptians, to bury his father. Vs. 7-9
  - F. They mourn for seven days at the threshing floor of Atad. Vs. 10
  - G. After seven days of mourning, they went to the cave of the field of Machpelah to bury Jacob. Vs. 11-13
- II. Joseph comforts his brothers. Vs. 14-21
  - A. The brothers of Joseph afraid of him since Jacob died. Vs. 14-15
  - B. They sent a false message to Joseph saying that Jacob wanted him to forgive his brothers. Vs. 16-17
  - C. Joseph tells them to "Fear not: for am I in the place of God? But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive. Now therefore fear ye not: I will nourish you, and your little ones. And he comforted them, and spake kindly unto them." Vs. 19-21
- III. Joseph dies. Vs. 22-26
  - A. Joseph died at the age of 110 years old. Vs. 22
  - B. Joseph saw his grandchildren before he died. Vs. 23
  - C. Joseph assured his brothers that God would take them out of Egypt. Vs. 24
  - **D.** Joseph requested that when God takes them out of Egypt, they are to take his body and bury it in Canaan. Vs. 25-26
