 - d. Jesus will return the second time to earth in a cloud. Revelation 1:7
 - 2. This cloud would be in Heaven. Hebrews 12:1
 - B. Can those in Heaven see us on earth or do they just hear the report?
 - 1. Rejoicing over a lost soul saved! Luke 15:7
 - 2. Abraham saw the day of Jesus and was glad. John 8:56
 - a. Did Abraham see the day of Jesus by faith only?
 - 1) Abraham saw virgin birth of Jesus in the birth of Isaac.
 - 2) Abraham saw Jesus crucified and raised by the sacrifice of Isaac. Hebrews 11:17-19
 - b. The Jews argued that Abraham was dead. John 8:52-53
 - c. Jesus had taught them that Abraham was alive. Matthew 22:32
 - d. Abraham saw the day of Jesus and was glad. John 8:56-58

 - A. Run to win. 1 Corinthians 9:24-27
 - B. Run according to the rules. 2 Timothy 2:5
- IV. What are the rules of the race? Hebrews 12:1-13:18

- A. Lay aside every weight and sin. Hebrews 12:1
 - 1. Put off the old ways. Ephesians 4:22-25
 - 2. Die to the old ways. Colossians 3:5-9
 - 3. Deny yourself. Luke 9:23
 - 4. Lay aside. 1 Peter 2:1
 - 5. Love not the things of the world. 1 John 2:15-17
 - 6. Be not overcharged with things of the world. Luke 21:34
- B. Run with patience. Hebrews 12:1
 - 1. The patience of Job. James 5:11
 - a. In spite of death in the family, finical lost, and sickness, Job held out knowing that the end was better than the beginning. Job 42:10, 12
- C. Run God's race. Hebrews 12:1
 - 1. To all Nations. Matthew 28:19
 - 2. To every creature. Mark 16:15
 - 3. To the uttermost part of the earth. Acts 1:8
- D. Keep your eye on Jesus. Hebrews 12:2
 - 1. Do not look back. Luke 9:62
 - 2. How can we look at Jesus?
 - a. By looking at the Bible. 1 John 1:1-3
 - b. The Word became flesh and the flesh became the Word. John 1:1-5, 14, Revelation 19:13
 - c. You will not see Jesus outside of the Bible.

- c. Jesus finished the sacrifice for our salvation.
- 3. Saw the joy of winning. Hebrews 12:2
 - a. At the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:2
 - b. A name above all names.
- 4. Enduring the hostility of sinners and did not become weary and discouraged. Hebrews 12:3
 - a. Endure hardness. 2 Timothy 2:3-4
 - b. Endure afflictions. 2 Timothy 4:2-8
 - c. Sufferings are not to be compared with the glory. Romans 8:18

- 3. God wants you to be the best. Hebrews 12:6
 - a. Quotation from Proverbs 3:12.
 - b. God only corrects his children. Hebrews 12:7-8
- 4. God wants you to partake of his holiness. Hebrews 12:9-11
 - a. Partakers of the divine nature. 2 Peter 1:4

 - a. Not fall from, but fail, come short of.
 - 3. Grace of God. Hebrews 12:15
 - a. Christian virtures that which affords joy, pleasure, delight, sweetness, charm, loveliness, good will, loving-kindness, favour.
 - 4. If you fail (come short) of the grace of God then:
 - a. You could become bitter. Hebrews 12:15
 - 1) A tongue of bitterness. James 3:8-18
 - b. You could be troubled. Hebrews 12:15
 - 1) Slow to believe. Luke 24:36-39
 - c. You could be defiled. Hebrews 12:15
 - 1) Your mind and conscience defiled. Titus 1:14-16
 - d. You could be a fornicator. Hebrews 12:16
 - 1) As Sodom and Gomorrha. Jude 1:7
 - e. You could be a profane person. Hebrews 12:16
 - 1) Show no difference between the unclean and clean. Ezekiel 22:26
 - 2) An example is Esau. Hebrews 12:16
 - a) He found no place of repentance. Hebrews 12:17

 - 2. Mount Sion (Zion)-Grace. Hebrews 12:22
 - B. Mount Sinai. Hebrews 12:18-21
 - 1. The mount that might be touch. Hebrews 12:18
 - a. They were instructed not to touch it. Exodus 19:9-15
 - b. As Adam and Eve were not to eat of the tree. Genesis 2:16-17

 - a. Under the law you are guilty before God. Romans 3:19
 - b. You cannot be justified by the law. Romans 3:20, Galatians 3:10-13

 - A. Mount Sion (Zion) is symbolic of the bride of Christ. Revelation 21:2, Revelation 21:9-10
