I. Let brotherly love continue. Hebrews 13:1

A. Love your neighbour. Luke 10:25-28

1. Who is my neighbour? Luke 10:29-37

B. Love the brethren, Christians.

1. In honour. Romans 12:10

2. That you might grow in the Lord. 2 Peter 1:5-9

3. Is to love one another. 1 Thessalonians 4:9

4. Love them as Christ loves us. John 13:34

5. You will be identified as a disciple of Christ. John 13:35

6. You will know that you are saved. 1 John 3:14

II. Entertain strangers. Hebrews 13:2

A. A stranger could be an angel.

B. Angels unawares. Hebrews 13:2

1. If angels had wings, then you would know that he was an angel.

2. Everyone in the Bible that met an angel did not know that it was an angel.

- a. An Angel, as a man of God, visited Manoah's wife. Judges 13:2-6

- b. What the man looked like. Judges 13:6-7

c. The Angel, as a man, visits Manoah and his wife. Judges 13:8-20

d. After the Angel left, then they knew he was an Angel. Judges 13:21

3. A creature with wings and an angel together, but no wings on the angel.
Zechariah 5:9-10

III. Remember those who are persecuted as they are part of the body. Hebrews 13:3

A. The saved are in the body of Christ. 1 Corinthians 12:18-27

IV. Marriage is honourable. Hebrews 13:4

A. Marriage is of God. Gen. 2:24

1. God created Adam and Eve, not Adam and Adam. Mark 10:6-9

2. A man is to love his wife, and the wife her husband. Ephesians 5:33

3. To avoid fornication. 1 Corinthians 7:2

4. Same sex marriage is an abomination. Leviticus 18:22, Leviticus 20:13

a. Same sex marriage is a vile affection. Romans 1:26-27

b. Sodom and Gomorrhah are examples of how wrong it is. Jude 1:7, 2 Peter 2:6

V. Whoremonger and adulterers God will Judge. Hebrews 13:4

A. Will be in the lake of fire. Revelation 21:8

B. Are you washed in the blood of the Lamb? 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, Revelation 1:5
