The kingdom of God's Son, Jesus, is in four divisions:

- 1. Jesus, the Son of Abraham,
- 2. Jesus, the Son of David,
- 3. Jesus, the Son of Man,
- 4. Jesus, the Son of God.

These four divisions describe his ministry.
