Matthew 16:13

Lesson 4

The kingdom of God's Son, Jesus, is in four divisions:

- 1. Jesus, the Son of Abraham,**
- 2. Jesus, the Son of David,**
- 3. Jesus, the Son of Man,**
- 4. Jesus, the Son of God.**

These four divisions describe his ministry.

Jesus came to this Earth as the Son of Abraham, as the Son of David, as the Son of Man and as the Son of God.

There are 85 verses in the Bible about Jesus as the Son of Man.

Matthew 16:13 "When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son of man am?"

28 Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded;

29 But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all.
