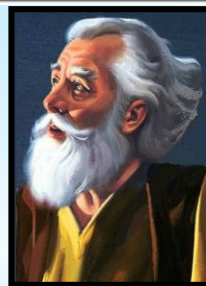

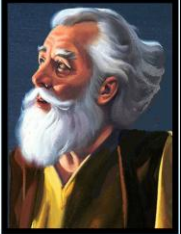
Genesis 17:18

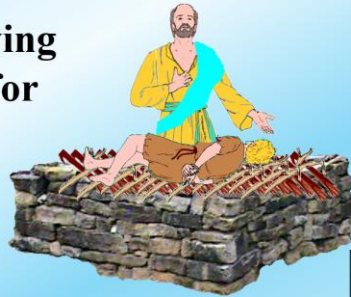

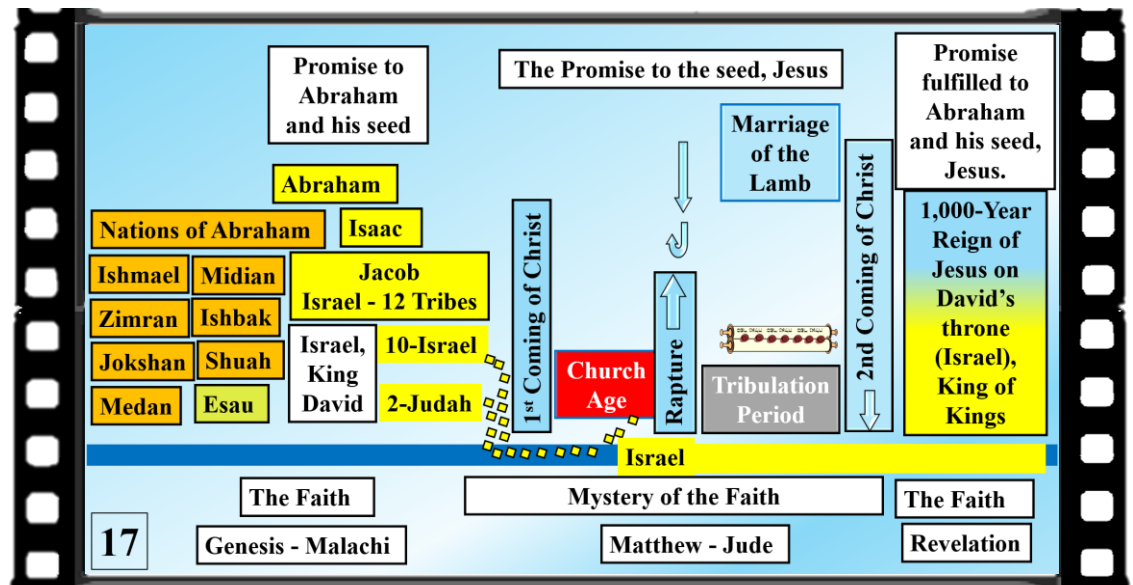
