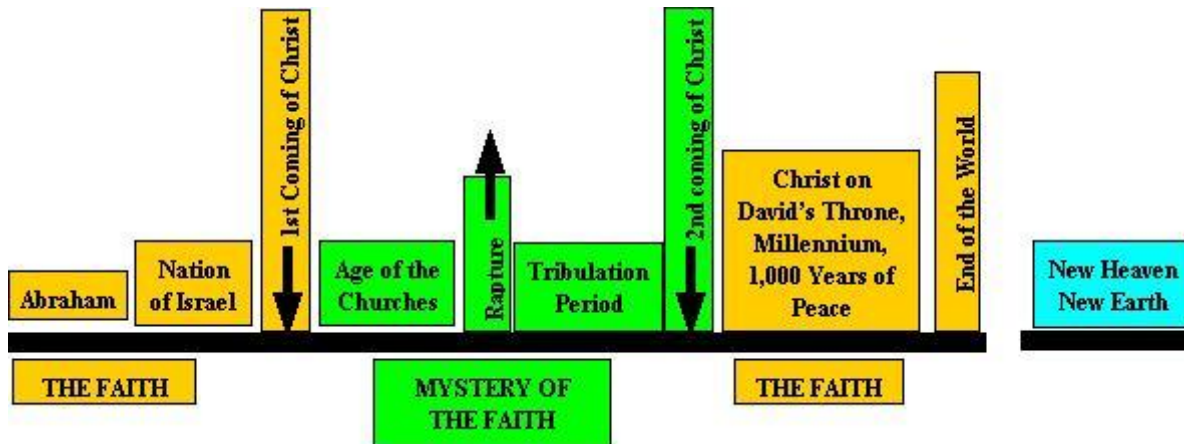


Mystery of the Faith Lesson 12
