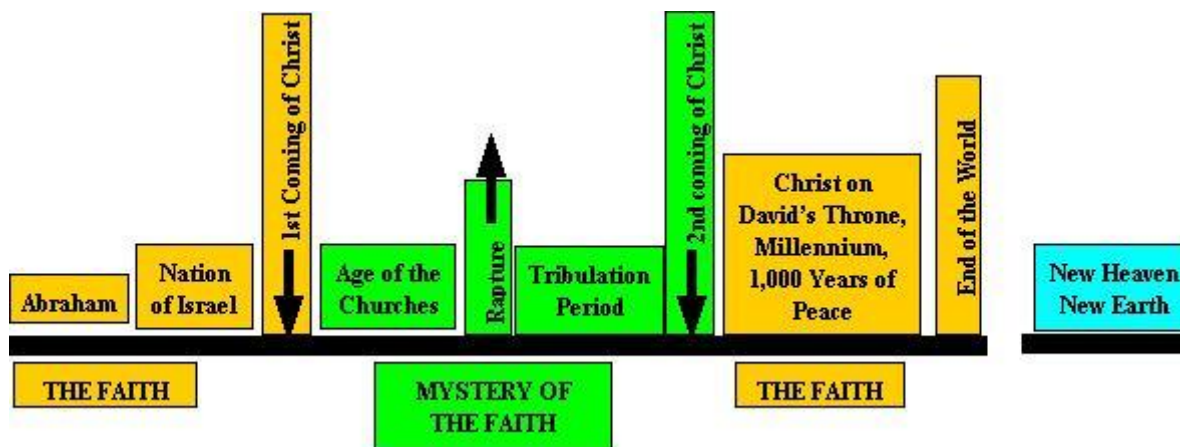


Mystery of the Faith Lesson 5
