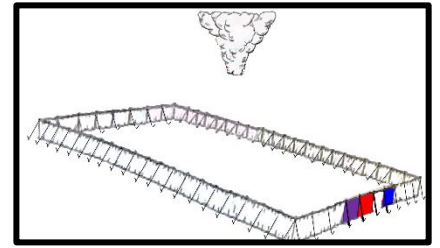

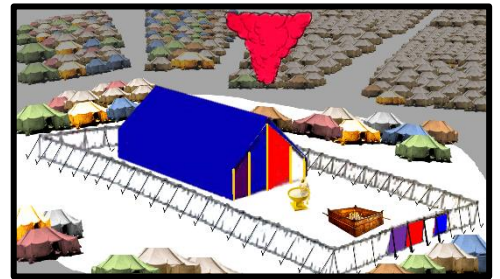
Lesson 2– The Court



Numbers 9:15 “And on the day that the tabernacle was reared up the cloud covered the tabernacle, namely, the tent of the testimony: and at even there was upon the tabernacle as it were the appearance of fire, until the morning.”

Numbers 9:16 “So it was always: the cloud covered it by day, and the appearance of fire by night.”

Numbers 9:17 “And when the cloud was taken up from the tabernacle, then after that the children of Israel journeyed: and in the place where the cloud abode, there the children of Israel pitched their tents.”



They would clear the place where the cloud stopped and set up the Tabernacle Court.

Exodus 27:18 “The length of the court shall be an hundred cubits, and the breadth fifty every where, and the height five cubits of fine twined linen, and their sockets of brass.”

Q1. The Tabernacle is enclosed by a court fence that is _____ cubits high.

To change cubits to feet:

1. One cubit equals 18 inches.
2. Multiply the number of cubits by 18.
3. Divide by 12.

$$\frac{\text{Cubits}}{18} * 18 = \frac{\text{Inches}}{12} \div 12 = \frac{\text{Feet}}{12}$$

$$\frac{\text{Cubits}}{1} * 18 = \frac{\text{Inches}}{12} = \frac{\text{Feet}}{1}$$

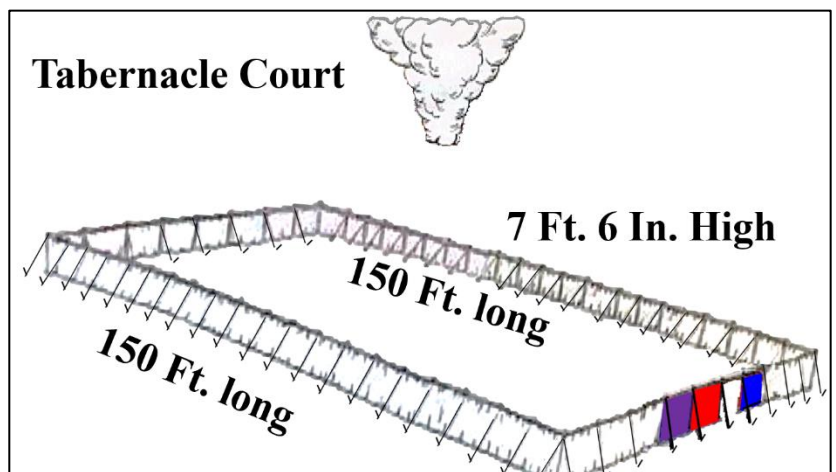

Q7. There is only ___ gate ___ cubits wide.

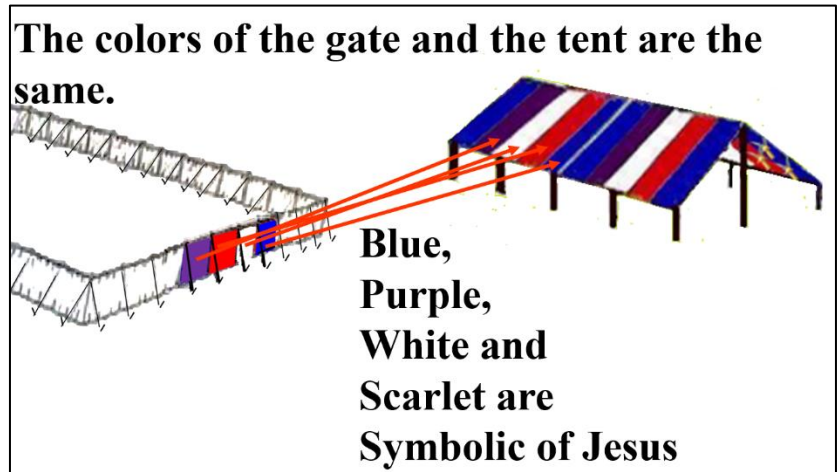
$$\frac{\text{Cubits}}{1} * 18 = \frac{\text{Inches}}{12} = \frac{\text{Feet}}{1}$$
