


Lesson 7

Acts 7:44 "Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the


wilderness, as he had appointed, speaking unto Moses, that he should make it according to the fashion that he had seen."

For the High Priest to meet with God in the Holly of Holies, he had to go through the Gate, the Door and the Vail.



John 14:6 "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."

The only way to the Tabernacle is one gate made of four colors.

Exodus 27:16 "And for the gate of the court shall be an hanging of twenty cubits, of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, wrought with needlework: and their pillars shall be four, and their sockets four."

White – Righteousness of Jesus

The Hebrew word for Linen is www shesh shaysh which means something bleached white, byssus, linen, fine linen.

**Purple-Kingship of Jesus** 

I Timothy 6:14 "That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ: 15 Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords;"

**Scarlet – The Blood of Jesus** 

Matthew 26:28 "For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins."

Matthew 7:13 "Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:


14 "Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it."
