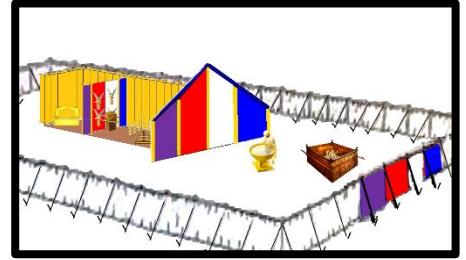


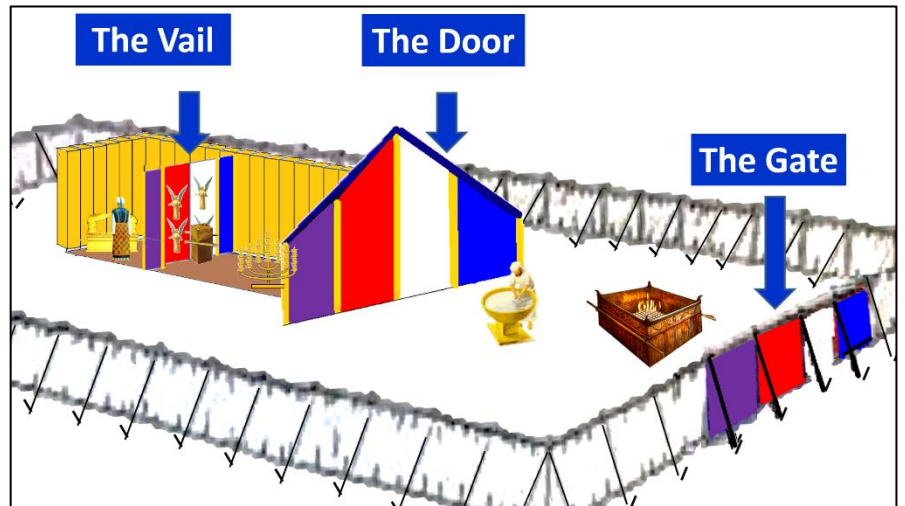

Lesson 8 The Truth The Door



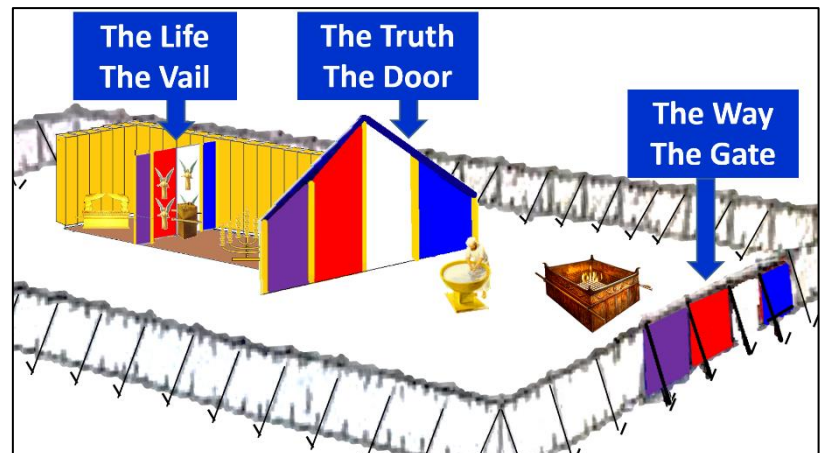
