


Acts 7:44 "Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the


wilderness, as he had appointed, speaking unto Moses, that he should make it according to the fashion that he had seen."

For the High Priest to meet with God in the Holly of Holies, he had to go through the Gate, the Door and the Vail.



The Hebrew word, Arown, which is translated "ark" in Exodus 25:22 and Exodus 26:33 literally means coffin. The Ark of Testimony in the Holy of Holies is a coffin that is symbolic of the death of Jesus.




