Joseph

The events in the life of Joseph are types of the events in the life Jesus.

Genesis 37:13

"And Israel said unto Joseph, Do not thy brethren feed *the flock* in Shechem? come, and I will send thee unto them. And he said to him, Here *am I*."

John 20:21

"Then said Jesus to them again, Peace *be* unto you: as *my* Father hath sent me, even so send I you."

Genesis 37:18

John 1:11

"He came unto his own, and his own received him not."

Genesis 37:28

"Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty *pieces* of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt."

5. Joseph was sold to the Ishmaelites for ___ pieces of silver.

Matthew 26:15

"And said *unto them*, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver."

Genesis 39:10

"And it came to pass, as she spake to Joseph day by day, that he hearkened not unto her, to lie by her, *or* to be with her."

Genesis 39:14-19

"That she called unto the men of her house, and spake unto them, saying, See, he hath brought in an Hebrew unto us to mock us; he came in unto me to lie with me, and I cried with a loud voice:

15 And it came to pass, when he heard that I lifted up my voice and cried, that he left his garment with me, and fled, and got him out.

16 And she laid up his garment by her, until his lord came home.

17 And she spake unto him according to these words, saying, The Hebrew servant, which thou hast brought unto us, came in unto me to mock me:

18 And it came to pass, as I lifted up my voice and cried, that he left his garment with me, and fled out.

19 And it came to pass, when his master heard the words of his wife, which she spake unto him, saying, After this manner did thy servant to me; that his wrath was kindled."

Mark 15:3-5

"And the chief priests accused him of many things: but he answered nothing.

4 And Pilate asked him again, saying, Answerest thou nothing? behold how many things they witness against thee.

5 But Jesus yet answered nothing; so that Pilate marvelled.

Mark 15:13-15

"And they cried out again, Crucify him.

14 Then Pilate said unto them, Why, what evil hath he done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, Crucify him.

15 And *so* Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged *him*, to be crucified."

Genesis 39:20

"And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners *were* bound: and he was there in the prison."

Matthew 27:57-60

"When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple:

58 He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered.

59 And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth,

60 And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed."

12. Jesus was buried in the tomb of _____.

Genesis 41:39-40

"And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Forasmuch as God hath shewed thee all this, *there is* none so discreet and wise as thou *art*:

40 Thou shalt be over my house, and according unto thy word shall all my people be ruled: only in the throne will I be greater than thou."

13. Was Joseph resurrected from prison and exalted to rule with Pharaoh?

Ephesians 1:20-23

"Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set *him* at his own right hand in the heavenly *places*,

21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

22 And hath put all *things* under his feet, and gave him *to be* the head over all *things* to the church,

23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all."
